**RE: Extension of Non-Mandatory Statewide Contract No. 1-08-65-54-A (Reverse
Distribution and Destruction - Guarantee Returns) to May 1, 2014.**

This Broadcast Bulletin announces the extension of the Reverse Distribution and Destruction Program's Participating Addendum with The Minnesota Multi-State Contracting Alliance for Pharmacy (MMCAP), through the vendor, Guaranteed Returns, to May 1, 2014.

This **Non-Mandatory** Statewide Reverse Distribution and Destruction - Guarantee Returns, Contract No. 1-08-65-54-A is for the return of expired or unused drugs for participating state and local agencies.

- State Agencies are reminded to check for specific return and/or pricing requirements for returns of products purchased from Pharmaceutical Wholesalers and/or manufacturers.
- Departments may also purchase like services from others, such as a state certified Small Business (SB) and Disabled Veterans Business Enterprise (DVBE) firms.
- State Agencies are reminded to identify and purchase from mandatory contracts prior to making purchases through this non-mandatory contract or through another vendor.
- DGS does not guarantee pricing through this contract is the lowest price available in the market.
- This contract **does not** provide any SB or DVBE incentive.
