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State's SB/DVBE Goals

- Requires state agencies to award at least **25%** of their annual contracting dollars to certified Small Business
- Military & Veterans Code Section 999 requires agencies to award at least **3%** to certified Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises (DVBE)

State's SB/DVBE Goals Fiscal Year 2015-16

- Statewide departments consist of mandatory and voluntary departments. There are 132 mandatory state departments required to report and another 30 state departments that report voluntarily.
- Ninety-six percent of all mandatory and voluntary departments submitted a report, which is an increase of 12 percentage points over last fiscal year.

State's SB/DVBE Goals Fiscal Year 2015-16

- Statewide departments awarded approximately \$8.1 billion in contracts with \$2.5 billion (up 4.2 percent) going to SBs/MBs and \$349 million (down 14.3 percent) going to DVBEs.
- Statewide participation achievements improved to 30.44 percent for SBs/MBs and 4.31 percent for DVBEs!

Small Business Eligibility Requirements

- To be eligible for SB certification, the business must meet the following criteria:
 - Must be independently owned and operated;
 - Cannot be dominant in the field of operation;
 - Must have its principal office located in California

Small Business Eligibility Requirements

- The business must also:
 - Have its owners (or officers in the case of a corporation) domiciled in California;
 - And, together with the affiliates, be either:
 - a business with 100 or fewer employees, and have an average annual gross receipts of \$14 million or less over the previous 3 tax years, *or*
 - a manufacturer with 100 or fewer employees

DVBE Definition

- For DVBE certification purposes, a “disabled veteran” is a veteran of the U.S. military, naval, or air service; and has a service connected disability of at least 10% or more as certified by the United States Department of Veteran Affairs and must be domiciled in the State of California.

DVBE Eligibility Requirements

- Most DVBEs can also be certified SBs
- To be eligible for DVBE certification, the business must meet the following criteria:
 - Be at least 51% owned by one or more disabled veterans (defined on next slide)
 - Limited Liability Companies (LLCs) must be wholly owned by one or more disabled veterans

DVBE Eligibility Requirements

- Daily business operations must be managed and controlled by one or more disabled veterans. The disabled veteran(s) who manages and controls the business is not required to be the disabled veteran business owner(s)
- The home office must be located in the United States. The home office cannot be a branch or subsidiary of a foreign corporation, foreign firm, or other foreign based business.

SB/DVBE First Policy

- Certified SB or DVBE
- Goods, Services, & IT goods and services - \$0.00 to \$249,999.99
- Public Works - \$0.00 to \$291,000.00
- At least two price quotes (2 SBs or 2 DVBEs)
- Department of General Services, Franchise Tax Board, Department of Veterans Affairs, Military Department, Department of Public Health, California Highway Patrol, California Department of Technology, Department of Education, California Public Utilities Commission, and Department of Consumer Affairs have the First Policy in place.

Register to do business with the State BIDDER REGISTRATION

Go to www.caleprocure.ca.gov using the latest version of your web browser. In the upper right hand corner, click *Login/ Register*; on the next page, click *Register as a Sourcing Bidder*.

Step 1 Preliminary Information. Choose either *Federal Employer Information Number (FEIN)* or *Social Security Number (SSN)* as your *Tax Identification Number (TIN)*, choose *Selling Goods/Services*. (Do not use dashes when entering FEIN or SSN).

Step 2 User Account Setup. All items with an asterisk must be completed. If you have a website, enter the link under *URLID*. NAICS Codes (North American Industry Classification System) is a required field for those applicants that are manufacturers ONLY.

Step 3 Primary Address. Complete all items marked with an asterisk.

Step 4 Add User. Depending on the number of users, you can have multiple entries for items such as *Invoice Address* or *Primary Address*.

Step 5 Other Business Details. Choose *Company Primary Industry* and *Keywords*. (Use the plus sign [+]) to add keywords. Add at least 3 keywords.) Make sure you check *Receive Bid Interest Notifications* and *Receive Certification Notifications*. Choose *Service Area(s)*.

Step 6 Bid Notification Preferences. *UNSPSC Code* (United Nations Standard Products and Services Codes) can be searched by code or keyword. Select at least one code that is appropriate to your company.

Step 7 Terms and Conditions. Click the required box to agree to the terms and conditions for state procurements. Click *Submit*.

Bidder Registration is complete. You will receive an email with your temporary password.

- **Look into becoming a California Multiple Award Schedules (CMAS) Contractor**



What is a CMAS

- A California Multiple Award Schedule (CMAS) is a streamlined, best value purchasing solution for State agencies and local governments seeking IT and Non-IT goods and services

What is a CMAS

- CMASs are not established through a competitive bid process conducted by the State of California
- Therefore, all pricing, products and/or services offered must have been previously bid and awarded on a Federal GSA Schedule

*California code does not allow for formal protest of CMAS transactions

What is a CMAS

- The CMAS Program does not "use" the Federal GSA Schedule
- Instead, the State of California establishes a totally independent multiple award schedule for the same products and/or services, based on the same prices



What is a CMAS

- A CMAS does not guarantee that your company will do business with the state of California or with local governments
- However, being awarded a CMAS places your company in a pool of potential contractors that ordering agencies can choose from



What is a Federal GSA Schedule

- The Federal GSA Schedule is a multiple award schedule for the federal government
- Products and/or services are assessed and evaluated
- A GSA Schedule contains pre-negotiated pricing, delivery terms, warranties, and other terms and conditions



CMAS/GSA Schedule Pricing

- The GSA Schedule terms and conditions and pricing must be published at the GSA eLibrary
- The GSA Schedule pricing posted at the eLibrary is the maximum allowed for each product and/or service
- When responding to a Request For Offer (RFO), CMAS suppliers can offer prices that are lower than the GSA Schedule pricing, but not higher



Basis for Offer

- Two Options:
 - 1) If the contractor already holds their own GSA Schedule, they can offer it as the base for their CMAS offer

****The CMAS Unit does not recommend applying for a GSA Schedule for the sole purposes of CMAS**

Basis for Offer

- Two Options:
 - 2) The contractor can offer products, services, and pricing from a Federal GSA Schedule held by another company. In this case, the process is referred to as "piggybacking"



CMAS Term

- The term of a CMAS begins on the date of award by the CMAS Unit, and runs concurrent with the Federal GSA Schedule.



CMAS Renewal

- CMAS contract renewals/extensions do NOT occur automatically when the term of the base GSA schedule is renewed or extended
- It is the responsibility of the CMAS contractor to monitor the GSA eLibrary for renewals or extensions
- Please see the “CMAS Contract Management & Information Guide” for specific details

Who Can Use CMAS

- State and local government agencies may use CMAS, unless the contractor explicitly stipulates in their CMAS contract offer that the CMAS is not available to local governments.
- A local government agency is any city, county, district, or other local governmental body, including the California State University (CSU) and University of California (UC) systems, K-12 public schools and community colleges empowered to expend public funds.



CMAS Program Fees

- There is no fee to apply for a CMAS
- For CMAS sales to State agencies, the State agency pays an administrative fee to the Department of General Services. CMAS contractors do not pay fees for sales to State agencies
- For CMAS sales to local government agencies, the CMAS contractor pays a 1% incentive fee to the Department of General Services based on the total value of the purchase order
- If the CMAS contractor is a California certified Small Business (SB), both the administrative and incentive fees are waived

What is Excluded

- Products and services from other DGS-Procurement Division contracts.
- Facility planning, medical services, registered nursing, human resources and security guard services.
- Legal Services
- Public works projects



What is Excluded (Con't)

- Architectural, Construction, Engineering, and Environmental Services
- Facilities Maintenance and Management services are not allowed on CMAS. Two exceptions are:
 - Third party verification services of greenhouse gas emission and reports for existing facilities and operations.
 - Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design for existing buildings (LEED – EB)

Fiscal Agents

- When a subcontractor ultimately performs all of the services that a prime contractor has agreed to provide, and the prime contractor only handles the invoicing of expenditures, then the prime contractor's role becomes that of a fiscal agent because it is merely administrative in nature. It is unacceptable to use fiscal agents in this manner because the agency is paying unnecessary administrative costs.

Once you become a certified firm or a CMAS contractor your business information is included in databases accessible to state purchasing officials. However, you must still market your products and services to state agencies.

- Most state agencies have an SB/DVBE Advocate to disseminate information on pending solicitations to SBs/DVBES, ensure prompt payments and resolve contracting issues. Find SB/DVBE Advocates at www.dgs.ca.gov/pd/advocate
- Some state agencies have delegated purchasing authority to allow them to contract directly with vendors. Find out which agencies have delegated purchasing authority at www.dgs.ca.gov/pd/delegated
- Find out what state agencies buy and the dollar amount of the contracts. Go to www.dgs.ca.gov/pd/Programs/calprocure/SCPRSDData.aspx

State agencies with annual expenditures over \$100,000 have available to small business and Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise (DVBE) suppliers, a liaison to help them resolve contracting issues with the state. The small business & DVBE advocate's duties must at minimum, include the following services:

- Make information regarding pending solicitations available to, and consider offers from, California small business suppliers capable of meeting the state's business need.
- Ensure that payments due on a contract with a small business are made promptly, as provided for in Government Code, Section 927 et seq. For more information, see the [Prompt Payment Program](#).

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

How to Introduce Yourself to State SB/DVBE Advocates

- Determine which agency meets your needs: State Contracting & Procurement Registration System (SCPRS), California State Contracts Register (CSCR), individual agency website
- Prepare 30 second “elevator” speech to include: Full Name, Business Name, What you sell, Supplier ID
- When possible send email to set up an appointment. That way, you are not playing phone tag
- Include Supplier ID number on business cards, websites and emails.
- Limit the attachments. Have attachment/brochure/capability statement (If including codes, make sure that they are applicable, e.g., UNSPSC for State and NAICS for Federal)
- Provide technical data to support claims, if needed
- Send attachment/brochure updates every 3 to 4 months via email
- Ensure all communication materials are clear and spell checked

Delegated Purchasing Authority

Statutory authority for the competitive and non-competitive procurement of non-Information Technology goods and Information Technology goods and services for State government resides with the Department of General Services. DGS also has the statutory authority to delegate its purchasing authority to departments that meet specific requirements.

Without delegated purchasing authority, departments may conduct competitive procurements for non-Information Technology goods valued at up to \$100 per transaction and may not conduct competitive and non-competitive procurements for Information Technology goods and services of any value.

Purchasing authority granted by DGS includes use of the State's leveraged procurement agreements (CMAS; Master Agreements, including WSCA, Statewide Contracts, State Price Schedules, and Software License Program), purchases from Prison Industry Authority, and purchases under the Community-Based Rehabilitation Program. Purchasing Authority is required to participate in the State's CAL-Card Purchase Card Program.

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




Reciprocity Program

- Keyword Search is a tool to use familiar words to locate related state agencies, e.g., Driver's Licenses = Department of Motor Vehicles, etc.
- 9-1-1 Instructions provides information for state employees use on when and who to call in an emergency situation.

Commercially Useful Function (CUF) Applicability

**All California-certified SBs and DVBEs
(contractors, subcontractors and
suppliers of goods/services)
bidding on / participating in a state contract,
regardless of the procurement approach
or the payment method used,
must perform CUF!**

For Small Business: Government Code 14837(d)(4)(A)

For DVBEs: Military and Veterans Code 999(b)(5)(B)

What is CUF?

A SB/DVBE certified firm...

Performs CUF when is doing all of the following:

- ✓ Executing a distinct element of the work of the contract.
- ✓ Performing, managing, or supervising the work.
- ✓ Performing work that is normal for the firm's business services and functions.
- ✓ Negotiating price, determining quality and quantity, ordering, installing, and making payment.
- ✓ Not subcontracting a portion of the work greater than expected by industry practices.

Does NOT perform CUF if:

- ✓ An extra participant in a transaction, contract, or project through which funds are passed in order to obtain the appearance of SB/DVBE participation.
- ✓ Not being used to perform the work as stipulated in the bid.
- ✓ No longer used to provide good/services listed in initial bid response.

CUF-Related Penalties and Sanctions

Military and Veteran Code 999.9

MVC 999.9(a) Violations, including CUF-related

MVC 999.9(b) Penalties and sanctions:

- **Misdemeanor: jail and/or \$1,000 fine**
- **Civil penalties:**
 - 1st violation: \$10,000 - \$30,000**
 - 2nd violation +: \$30,000 - \$50,000/each**
- **Costs and attorney's fees**

MVC 999.9(c) DGS authority to:

- **Suspend from doing business with the state 3-10 years**
- **Revoke SB and/or DVBE certification for :**
 - 1st violation : 5 years**
 - 2nd violation: 10 years**
- **Refer to Attorney General for civil penalties if sufficient grounds**
