

ORIM's EMMP Program

Cost Savings

- 25% immediate savings from previous maintenance contract costs.
- Current savings of almost \$3M annually

Participation

- 23 Participating departments include, i.e. DGS, CDCR, CDPH, CDT, DOJ, CDFW, WaterBoards, DPR, CalVet, DOE, OSPD, CHHS, DOT, HSR, OSHPD, CDFA, CalLottery, CalRecycle, DBO, DHCS, DMHC, DSH, and EMSA

Statistics

- Covers 28,000 equipment assets (IT, Medical, Scientific, and General Office) in offices throughout the State.
- Over 8,000 scheduled maintenance events / repairs have been completed on covered equipment.

Administrative Savings

- Maintenance insurance premium is billed on an annual basis in lieu of monthly or quarterly.
- Departments no longer need to go out to RFP / Bid. This requirement has already been met by ORIM through the Alliant Insurance Services Contract
- An estimated 11 hours of PY time per piece of equipment is saved as a result.

Vendors

- Opportunity for the service community to compete with larger service companies.
- The Alliant Insurance Services contract utilizes 5% DVBE participation.
- SB / DVBE savings are captured by an online report.
- SB / DVBE vendors are utilized.
- Offices have the flexibility to choose their vendors.
- Equipment is served even if there is no State Budget as the insurance premium is paid by June 30th of each year.

Centralized Asset Management

- All equipment is consolidated into one Master Insurance Program.
- One place to call for service: One toll free number to call for service for the State with 24 x 7 accessibility available.
- Complete equipment visibility with an equipment online system for all end users.
- Captures all maintenance and service events by equipment.
- Equipment can be deleted and added at any time during the policy term.
