**CMAS SOFTWARE/MAINTENANCE RENEWAL
CLARIFICATIONS**

The following clarifications to the terms of CMAS Contract No. 3-00-70-1082A (CMAS Contract) held by Executive Information Systems LLC (Contractor) shall apply with respect to the maintenance renewal of SAS software (Software) pursuant the CMAS Contract:

1. Acceptance of Software: The parties acknowledge that: (a) the Software does not constitute Work Product as defined in Section 37 of the General Provisions – Information Technology (“CMAS GPIT”) of the CMAS Contract; and (b) since the Software has been previously delivered to, and licensed by, the customer (Customer) prior to the commencement date (“Commencement Date”) of the maintenance renewal period for the Software, as of the Commencement Date, the Software is accepted by the Customer.
2. Software Product Authorization Codes: The parties acknowledge that: (a) a Product Authorization Code is a code that is a component of the Software and that enables the Software to operate for the applicable license period with respect to the Software as previously purchased by the Customer, (b) the Customer must apply a new “Product Authorization Code” if required as a result of hardware or Software changes; (c) the Product Authorization Code is not considered to be a harmful code as defined in Section 18 of the CMAS GPIT.
3. Accessibility: With respect to Section 7(d) of the CMAS GPIT, the parties acknowledge that in connection with Contractor’s obligation to respond to and resolve complaints brought to its attention regarding accessibility of the Software, (a) Contractor shall be responsible for responding to such complaints brought to Contractor by the Customer’s designated point of contact with respect to the Software, (b) Contractor may, but shall not be required to, modify or enhance any such Software to resolve such complaints, and (b) the resolution of a complaint may consist of provision of information by Contractor setting forth the extent to which the Software currently supports applicable accessibility criteria established by the U.S. Federal Government and/or any plans of Contractor to enhance the accessibility of the Software.
