1 SCOPE

This document outlines the requirements for a coagulant which is formulated for use in potable water treatment application.

2 APPLICABLE SPECIFICATIONS / STANDARDS / CODES

Specifications, standards and codes referenced in this document in effect on the opening of the 'Invitation for Bid', form a part of this specification.

3 REQUIREMENTS

3.1 GENERAL

The liquid coagulant shall meet the following requirements:

- 3.1.1 Shall contain amine polymer filter aid.
- 3.1.2 Shall be certified as suitable for treatment of drinking water by an accredited certification organization in accordance with ANSI/NSF standard 60, Drinking Water Treatment Chemicals-Health Effects. The certification organization shall be accredited by the American National Standards Institute.
- 3.1.3 NFPA 704/HMIS rating of no greater than:
a) Health: 1/2, b) Flammability: 1/1, Instability: 0/0
- 3.1.4 Shall form a compact de-watered sludge.
- 3.1.5 Shall function well in water temperatures between 6°C to 22°C.
- 3.1.6 Shall function over a pH range of 6.0 to 10.0.
- 3.1.7 Shall be designed to treat raw water from 1- 1000 NTU turbidity and shall reduce turbidity by at least 80% when tested according to US EPA Method # 180.1 or other equivalent test method.
- 3.1.8 Shall resist chlorine and be usable in pre-chlorinated water without reduction in activity.
- 3.1.9 Shall be completely soluble in water.
- 3.1.10 Shall have 0.0% Volatile Organic Compounds (VOC).
- 3.1.11 Shall be classified as a non-hazardous product.
- 3.1.12 Shall not require any mixing before use.
- 3.1.13 Shall not require any special storage conditions.
- 3.1.14 Shall be stable for extended period of storage.
