EXECUTIVE ORDER B - 79 - 81

WHEREAS, the State of California is dedicating a newly constructed office building on Site 1A; and

WHEREAS, Gregory Bateson was one of the most accomplished thinkers of our generation; and

WHEREAS, the works of his lifetime have advanced human knowledge in the fields of biology, psychology, anthropology and philosophy; and

WHEREAS, Gregory Bateson served with distinction as a public servant on the faculty of the University of California at Santa Cruz and as a member of the University of California's Board of Regents; and

WHEREAS, Gregory Bateson was especially concerned with the relationships between mind and nature and recognized the necessity of human beings living in accord with sound environmental principles; and

WHEREAS, the building on Site 1A is a reflection of this philosophy in that it was designed for energy efficiency and on a scale to meet the human needs of the people who work in it.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Edmund G. Brown Jr., Governor of the State of California, by virtue of the power and authority vested in me by the Constitution and statutes of the State of California, do hereby issue order to become effective immediately;

The new state office building at Site 1A in the City of Sacramento dedicated May 1, 1981 shall be known as the "Gregory Bateson Building" in honor of his contributions to the State of California and mankind.
