

CBSC STAFF REPORT OSHPD 05/15 – Part 5

PROPOSING STATE AGENCY:

Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD)

APPLICATION AFFECTED:

General acute-care hospitals and acute psychiatric hospitals, skilled nursing facility, intermediate care facilities, licensed clinic and correctional treatment center construction.

SUBJECT:

This proposed action would repeal the 2013 Uniform Plumbing Code and adopt the 2015 Uniform Plumbing Code by reference with OSHPD amendments to be used as the 2016 California Plumbing Code.

CBSC Code Advisory Committee (CAC) Comments/Recommendations

CBSC's PLUMBING ELECTRICAL MECHANICAL & ENERGY CAC (PEME) recommended Approve as Submitted and Disapprove. OSHPD's accepted the CAC recommendations.

Public Comments received during 45-Day public comment period from October 9, 2015, until 5:00 PM on November 23, 2015.

Public comments were received as follows:

1. **F. Hampton III**, Lubrizol Advanced Materials, Inc., Comment dated October 28, 2015, Recommends: **Approve as Submitted** Section 604.1. See Final Statement of Reasons (FSOR) for agency's response.
2. **S. Smith**, Environmental Resources Management Limited, Comment dated November 23, 2015, Recommends: **Approve as Submitted** Section 604.1. OSHPD agreed with the support comment. See FSOR for agency's response.
3. **C. Hummel**, California Hospital Assoc., Comment dated November 16, 2015, Recommends: **Approve as Submitted** the entire OSHPD 06/15 package. OSHPD agreed with the support comment. See FSOR for agency's response.

Staff Findings:

OSHPD's Submittal appears to be compliant with the Administrative Procedure Act and Building Standards Law.

COMMISSION ACTION:

Staff prepared color Commission Action Matrix's which group the proposed regulations as follows:
