Jane Taylor came to the California Building Standards Commission (CBSC) in August of 2004, as an Associate Architect. Appointed to the position of Senior Architect in July of 2007, she leads CBSC's technical team who supports the commission in its adoption of building codes for the State of California.

Over the last three years, Ms. Taylor has worked with staff and other state agencies in the development and adoption of California's Green Building Standards Code (CALGreen), the first of its kind in the nation.

Prior to joining CBSC, Ms. Taylor returned to school after thirteen years of state service and received her Bachelor of Arts in Architecture from California State Polytechnic University, Pomona, in 1985. She then worked for almost twenty years in the private sector as a licensed architect on such projects as public schools, commercial and municipal buildings, and affordable housing.
