Mr. Tom Morrison was appointed Deputy Executive Director of the California Building Standards Commission (CBSC) in August of 2001. He is responsible for all administrative activities of the commission and acts as CBSC's Legislative Program Coordinator.

Mr. Morrison came to CBSC from the Office of Real Estate Appraisers, where he served as Legislative Program Coordinator and Public Information Officer from 1996 to 2001. Prior to that, he served as an associate analyst and later office manager with CBSC from 1981 to 1996, and an associate labor market analyst with the Employment Development Department from 1978 to 1981. During his years of service with CBSC, he gained experience in almost every program area.
