7) Proposed Emergency Standards Adoptions and Approvals;

- a) **Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD EF 01/10)** Certification of compliance and permanent approval of emergency building standards that were adopted by CBSC in January and pertain to the 2007 California Administrative Code, California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Part 1. The proposed action amends regulations contained in Chapter 6 and are necessary to update the requirements related to Hazards U.S. (HAZUS) methodology to reclassify hospital buildings with assigned Structural Performance Category -1 (SPC-1) to Structural Performance Category-2 (SPC-2) based on a collapse probability assessment, consistent with seismic safety requirements of SB 1953 (Chapter 740, Statutes of 1994). These regulations are being submitted pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 130022, which was recently enacted by SB 499 (Chapter 601, Statutes of 2009).
