

3) Proposed Code Adoption and Approvals: The Commission will take action on the following item to approve, disapprove, further study, or approve as amended the proposed code changes based on the criteria established in Health and Safety Code 18930.

a) **California Building Standards Commission:** The Commission will repeal amendments to the 2007 edition of the California Plumbing Code (California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Part 5) relating to PEX tubing. The provisions being repealed are contained in Section 604.11 and Table 6-4, which authorized the use of PEX water supply piping. Additionally, this action repeals the amendments added to Table 6-4 that reflected findings in the Environmental Impact Report upon which CBSC relied in its rulemaking.
