



Report, "Adoption of Statewide Regulations Allowing the Use of PEX Tubing," (State Clearinghouse No. 2007102143) and the adoption of findings reflecting that:

- (1) The Final Environmental Impact Report has been completed in compliance with CEQA;
- (2) The California Building Standards Commission has reviewed and considered the information within the Final Environmental Impact Report prior to approving the project;
- (3) The Final Environmental Impact Report reflects the California Building Standards Commission's independent judgment and analysis; and,
- (4) Changes or alterations have been required in, or incorporated into the project that mitigate or avoid the potentially significant impact as identified in the Final Environmental Impact Report.

**5) Proposed Emergency Standards Adoptions and Approvals;** The Commission will take action on the following items to approve, disapprove, further study, or approve as amended any of the proposed code changes based on the criteria established in Health and Safety Code 18930. The Commission will consider each agency's proposed changes and justifications, findings of emergency, and comments submitted during the public comment periods where applicable. The public may comment on any proposed code changes. - a) **The Building Standards Commission (BSC EF 01/10):** Proposed adoption of amendments to the 2007 and 2010 editions of the California Plumbing Code (California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Part 5). The proposed action amends Section 604.1.2, 604.11, 604.11.1, 604.11.2 and Table 6-4. Amendments to Table 6-4 reflect findings in the Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) upon which CBSC relied in its rulemaking.
- b) **The Division of the State Architect (DSA-SS EF 01/10):** Proposed adoption of amendments to the 2007 and 2010 editions of the California Plumbing Code (California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Part 5). The proposed action amends Section 604.1.2, 604.11, 604.11.1, 604.11.2 and Table 6-4. Amendments to Table 6-4 reflect findings in the Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) upon which CBSC relied in its rulemaking.
- c) **The Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD EF 01/10):** Proposed adoption of amendments to the 2007 and 2010 editions of the California Plumbing Code (California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Part 5). The proposed action amends Section 604.1.2, 604.11, 604.11.1, 604.11.2 and Table 6-4. - d) **The Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHDP EF 02/10):** Proposed adoption of amendments to the 2007 and 2010 editions of the California Plumbing Code (California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Part 5). The proposed action amends Section 604.1.2, 604.11, 604.11.1, 604.11.2 and Table 6-4. Amendments to Table 6-4 reflect findings in the Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) upon which CBSC relied in its rulemaking.
- e) **The Department of Public Health (CDPH 01/10):** Proposed approval of amendments to the 2007 and 2010 editions of the California Plumbing Code (California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Part 5). The proposed action amends Section 604.1.2, 604.11, 604.11.1, 604.11.2 and

Table 6-4. Amendments to Table 6-4 reflect findings in the Final Environmental Impact Report (SRDEIR) upon which CBSC relied in its rulemaking.

- f) **The Department of Food and Agriculture (AGR 01/10):** Proposed approval of amendments to the 2007 and 2010 editions of the California Plumbing Code (California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Part 5). The proposed action amends Section 604.1.2, 604.11, 604.11.1, 604.11.2 and Table 6-4. Amendments to Table 6-4 reflect findings in the Final Environmental Impact Report (FEIR) upon which CBSC relied in its rulemaking.
- g) **Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD EF 02/10)** Proposed adoption as an emergency and certification of compliance and permanent approval of Appendix Chapter A3 of the 2009 International Existing Building Code (IEBC), "Prescriptive Provisions for Seismic Strengthening of Cripple Walls and Sill Plate Anchorage of Light, Wood-Frame Residential Buildings", with amendment into the 2007 and 2010 California Existing Building Code.
- h) **Division of State Architect Structural Safety (DSA/SS EF 02/10)** proposed changes to the administrative regulations in the California Administrative Code, Title 24, Part 1, Chapter 4 regarding certification of school building projects. The regulations intend to streamline the certification process and eliminate a backlog of 12,000 projects occupied without certification.

**6) Proposed Code Adoption and Approvals:** The Commission will take action on the following item to approve, disapprove, further study, or approve as amended any of the proposed code changes based on the criteria established in Health and Safety Code 18930. The Commission will consider each agency's proposed changes and its justifications, the Code Advisory Committee (CAC) recommendations, and comments submitted during the public comment periods. The public may comment on any challenges to the proposals or CAC recommendations submitted during the public processes. No new issues or new information challenging the proposed code changes may be presented to the Commission in the adoption of the following proposed regulations.
