**REGARDING THE CALIFORNIA ADMINISTRATIVE CODE,
CALIFORNIA CODE OF REGULATIONS, TITLE 24, PART 1, CHAPTER 7**

Health Facilities Construction

The Administrative Procedure Act (APA) requires that an Initial Statement of Reasons be available to the public upon request when rulemaking action is being undertaken. The following information required by the APA pertains to this particular rulemaking action:

Section 7-111, Definitions: "Actual Construction Cost" is being added to this section to provide further definition and clarification of construction costs as the basis for OSHPD fees charged for plan review and construction observation of hospital or skilled nursing facility projects.
