I have been a licensed practicing architect in Sonoma County for thirty years. Resourceful use of our water is becoming more important every year.

I am quite pleased that the State of California has made a major change to the waste disposal code, allowing for a no-permit requirement for washing machines and single fixture systems. I do believe the twelve requirements for the no-permit system will meet basic public health issues.

It is much better that we have a workable grey-water code that does not require people to go to great lengths for a permit than to have un-permitted grey-water systems.
