

**NOTICE OF 15-DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD FOR PROPOSED

The Department of Water Resources' (DWR) is providing notice of proposed changes for incorporation into the 2010 California Residential Code, Title 24, Part 2.5, which were the subject of written comments from the initial 45 day public comment period that began on October 2, 2009 and ended on November 16, 2009.
