NOTICE OF CONTINUATION OF MEETING ACCESSIBILITY CODE ADVISORY COMMITTEE*

THE CALIFORNIA BUILDING STANDARDS COMMISSION'S ACCESSIBILITY CODE ADVISORY COMMITTEE will be continuing its previously noticed public meeting held on January 26 and 27, 2005, to complete a technical review of agendized code changes to the 2001 California Building Code proposed in the 2004 Annual Code Adoption Cycle by the Department of General Services, Division of the State Architect, Access Compliance, Department of Housing and Community Development, and Office of the State Fire Marshal, and to ensure adequate opportunity for public participation.
