Well, are you ready for CALGreen? The buzz concerning the new 2010 California Green Building Standards Code (CALGreen) is definitely increasing as our efforts to inform industry stakeholders that come January 1, 2011 new mandatory provisions go into effect for all new buildings. The CBSC in collaboration with the Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) is extremely busy preparing and presenting CALGreen educational programs throughout the state.

The CALGreen education campaign was launched at the [Green California Summit and Exposition](#) in Sacramento in March. CBSC, HCD, Division of the State Architect (DSA), and the Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development (OSHPD) participated in the summit with a CALGreen exhibit. We also presented an all day CALGreen pre-summit workshop, and a CALGreen education session.

In addition to the new CALGreen code, the 2010 California Building Standards Code (Title 24) triennial update will be published in early July. Upon availability you may access the 2010 code online (with the exception of Part 3: The Electrical Code) at www.bsc.ca.gov.
