

Suggested Revisions to the Text of the Regulations:

7-119(a) 3.A. Nomenclature in the Functional Program

- A. The names for spaces and departments used in the functional program shall be consistent with those used in the California Building Code. If acronyms are used, they should be defined clearly. If alternate names are used by the hospital operating model, a key to the alternate names that clearly identifies the names and spaces used in the California Building Code shall be submitted.

Reason:

Use of the same names as defined in the regulations is an issue because it will prevent the documents from being used in the manner identified in **7-119(a)2**. The hospital needs to use the names that they operate under which does not always match T22 and T24 names. We should be able to provide OSHPD a key to the names in lieu of using the OSHPD names.
