**Suggested Revisions to the Text of the Regulations:**

**1224.3. Definitions**

**RESTRICTED AREA.** A designated space with limited access eligibility. Such space has one or more of the following attributes: specific signage, physical barriers, security controls and protocols that delineate requirements for monitoring, maintenance, attire, and use. The term is often applied to specialized procedure suites, such as operating rooms and suites, interview-interventional imaging, cardiology-cath cardiac catheterization labs, angiography suites, etc.

**Reason:**

(6) The proposed building standard is not unnecessarily ambiguous or vague, in whole or in part.

Use industry standard nomenclature without abbreviations to provide clear and unambiguous language. Interview should be changed to interventional and cardiology cath to cardiac catheterization
