I wish to comment on the Notice of Proposed Action (NOPA) to Building Standards of the California Building Standards Commission (CBSC) Regarding Amendments to the 2013 California Building Standards Code, Title 24, California Code of Regulations (CCR), Part 11, California Green Building Standards Code.

I would like to see a provision added prohibiting the planting of noxious weeds, as defined by the California Department of Food and Agriculture, and invasive weeds, as defined by the California Invasive Plant Council, in new construction projects (including additions and renovations) that trigger a permit review. Doing so will save the State, Counties, Cities, farmers, and homeowners millions of dollars over the next few decades in combatting the spread of noxious and invasive weeds. Stopping the spread of noxious and invasive weeds will protect our farms and open spaces.
