

**Suggested Revisions to the Text of the Regulations:**

11B-208.2.3.4 requests for accessible parking spaces. When assigned parking is provided, designated accessible parking for the adaptable residential dwelling units shall be provided on ~~requests of residents with disabilities on~~ the same terms and with the full range of choices (e.g., off-street parking, carport or garage) for residents with disabilities that are available to other residents.

**Reason:** [The reason should be concise if the request is for "Disapproval," "Further Study," or "Approve As Amend" and identify at least one of the 9-point criteria (following) of Health and Safety Code §18930.]

Striking out the language "requests of residents with disabilities" will remove an unenforceable code provision, while providing clear direction for designing built-in parking elements for disabled persons. The public interest requires the adoption of these building standards.
