My name is Chris Prudhomme and I live in San Jose. I think the new greywater code for the state of California is a huge step forward, and think the no-permit requirement for washing machine and single fixture systems is a critical aspect of the code. This will make simple greywater systems economical for Californians seeking to conserve water, and will result in considerable water conservation over the years to come. On my own suburban lot, the water from the shower and washing machine alone would satisfy most of my irrigation needs, and will save a considerable amount of water every year. The 12 requirements for the no-permit systems provide sound guidance to protect the environmental and public health, while also supporting greywater reuse.

Please keep that part of the code intact and continue in this direction of removing barriers of permits and fees for simple sustainable practices.
