I am very pleased with the new greywater code for the state of California, and think the no-permit requirement for washing machine and single fixture systems is a very important aspect of the code. This will make simple greywater systems economical for Californians seeking to conserve water. The 12 requirements for the no-permit systems will protect environmental and public health, while supporting greywater reuse.

I have a simple, gravity flow greywater system from my clothes washer to basins around my fruit trees. My neighbors were fascinated when I installed the system with the help of the Greywater Guerillas but many have been stymied from continuing once they speak with our municipal permit departments.

Please keep the greywater part of the code intact and continue in this direction of removing barriers of permits and fees for simple sustainable practices.
