I am very pleased with the new greywater code for the state of California, and think the no-permit requirement for washing machine and single fixture systems is a very important aspect of the code. We have a huge vegetable and native plant garden and want it to thrive on our greywater, not drinking-water treated, pristine Hetch Hetchy water. Your proposed code changes will make simple greywater systems economical for my family who is constantly looking for more ways to conserve water. The 12 requirements for the no-permit systems will protect environmental and public health, while supporting greywater reuse.

Please keep that part of the code intact and continue in this direction of removing barriers of permits and fees for simple sustainable practices.
