I am very pleased with the new graywater code for the state of California, and think the no-permit requirement for washing machine and single fixture systems is the seminal aspect of the code. This will make simple graywater systems feasible for normal Californians seeking to conserve water and preserve our state's fragile aquatic ecosystems. The 12 requirements for the no-permit systems will protect environmental and public health, while supporting graywater reuse.
