Subject: 45-Day language

Good morning Doug,

I hope things are well.

The CALBO State Code Committee reviewed the current 45 Day packages, and we would like to again thank you, for HCD's brevity, and commitment to making as few changes as possible.

We do have one request of you.

We ask that you consider making a couple of slight amendments to HCD's proposed language on the C.O. alarms (CBC sections 420.4.2.1 and 420.4.2.2; and CRC sections R315.2.1 and R315.2.2). We believe that as currently proposed, there is some confusion as to how and when the alarms are to be installed. I have included some recommended language developed by the committee. While we're not married to this exact language, we would ask that you tweak your proposed language to make it a little bit more clear.

I'm also forwarding a copy of the letter we are sending to the CBSC and SFM. You'll note that we recommended the SFM revise their proposed smoke alarm language to correlate with HCD's carbon monoxide alarm language.
