

What Will BidSync's Replacement be Called

The new online procurement portal the state of California is launching in late 2015 will be called "Cal eProcure," officials say.

The new in-house procurement system, which will replace the third-party BidSync system the state currently uses, is part of the Financial Information System for California (FI\$Cal) project. The go-live date for the procurement portal is scheduled for Dec. 9.

"We chose a name for the new portal that is easily recognized by major customers, users, and suppliers, and yields optimal results in major search engines, said Department of General Services Deputy Director Jim Butler, who is the state's chief procurement officer. "We are optimistic that once launched, Cal eProcure will improve the experience of our customers in buying, selling and exploring transactions with the state."
