

Facilities Management Division (FMD)



The Facilities Management Division provides building management and administration, operations, maintenance, janitorial, groundskeeping, and repair services necessary to support the state's real estate assets. The Facilities Management Division:



- Operates and maintains sustainable state facilities that are energy- and water-efficient and environmentally friendly.
- Oversees 79 state-owned properties, including 58 office buildings. The balance of buildings include warehouses, storage, the state printing plant, the state's central heating and cooling plant, stand-alone parking structures, and state records warehouse.
- Provides state agencies with partial building management services, historically serving approximately 200 state-owned buildings.
