**DISTRICTS GET MONEY:** Two area school districts will receive state funding for new construction projects, the State Allocation Board announced Wednesday. Gratton School District in Denair was awarded \$1.6 million and Hart-Ransom Union School District in Modesto will be given \$77,000. The board reported that more than \$153 million will be doled out to 62 public school agencies throughout the state for the construction, modernization, and emergency repair of schools. The board is responsible for determining the allocation of state resources, such as proceeds from general obligation bond issues and other designated state funds used for the construction and modernization of local public school facilities.
