

## County school districts get funds for repair work

The State Allocation Board has awarded more than \$3 million to local school districts for emergency repairs.

The recipients are Chula Vista Elementary School District, \$172,217; Escondido Union School District, \$1,718,000; Oceanside Unified School District, \$16,900; and San Diego Unified School District, \$1,131,146.

The board is responsible for allocating state money, such as proceeds from general obligation bond issues and other funds used for the construction, modernization and repair of public schools.

The board met Wednesday in Sacramento.
