**WHAT:** Holiday shoppers can find great gift-giving items Saturday when the California Department of General Services opens its surplus property warehouse to the public, offering deals on computers, cell phones, furniture, jewelry, clothing, and much more.

**Auction Preview Day:** Friday, November 30, 2012, 8:00 a.m. to 3:30 pm.

**Auction Day:** Saturday, December 1, 2012.

*Auction:* Begins at 10:00 a.m.

**SUMMARY:** Hundreds of surplus items such as office furniture, computers (some bundled with monitors and accessories), cell phones, cameras, clothing, and antiques will be available for bidding by the general public. The items available were seized by the California Highway Patrol or confiscated by the National Transportation Security Administration (full list of items available [here](#)). Many items are sold in bulk packages, while some are sold individually. In order to register, bidders must submit a \$100 refundable **cash** deposit on preview day or the day of the auction.
