



to receive updates about the launch of Cal eProcure.

Cal eProcure is the new online portal designed to improve the experience of businesses selling products and services to the state of California. Launching December 2015, this new system replaces BidSync, giving businesses access to bidding and contracting resources in one location. Cal eProcure is user-friendly and responsively designed for mobile devices.

By replacing BidSync, Cal eProcure becomes the portal for access to advertised bid opportunities with the state of California in the California State Contracts Register (CSCR). It also provides access to the State Contracting and Procurement Registration System (SCPRS), Small Business and Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise (SB/DVBE) certification and queries, and statewide Leveraged Procurement Agreement (LPA) search functions.

General Access Features

The public will be able to access procurement information—without needing to register or log in. General access includes the ability to:

- Search for bid opportunities
- Search for certified SB/DVBEs
- Search for state purchases and contracts
- Search for LPAs

Supplier Registration

Suppliers are encouraged to register and create a business profile so they will be able to access state of California bidding and contracting resources in one user-friendly location through Cal eProcure and:

-  Maintain notifications for bidding opportunities advertised in CSCR
-  Apply for or renew SB/DVBE certification
-  Follow procurement transactions including purchase orders, receipts, invoices and payments
-  Maintain supplier record and contact information

For currently certified SB/DVBEs, the supplier record will include certification data—such as certification history, existing certification number and keywords associated with the BidSync profile—and CSCR notifications. In order to maintain and update records, businesses will need to register in Cal eProcure.

Certified SB/DVBEs, as well as all businesses engaged with departments transacting in FI\$Cal, will be contacted with registration instructions on how to match up with their existing supplier record.

What is the Financial Information System for California?

FI\$Cal is a business transformation project for the state of California in the areas of budgeting, accounting, procurement, and cash management. The project will prepare the state systems and workforce to function in an integrated financial management system environment. FI\$Cal is a historic partnership between the Department of Finance, the State Controller's Office, the State Treasurer's Office and the Department of General Services.
