

Office of Fleet and Asset Management (OFAM)



The Office of Fleet and Asset Management oversees the state's vehicle fleet, rental cars, parking facilities and surplus auctions. The Office of Fleet and Asset Management:

- Provides oversight of the state's 50,000-plus fleet of mobile assets to improve overall utilization and lower the cost of ownership.
- Operates the State Garage in Sacramento, which provides long and short-term rental cars to state employees, and manages more than 25 parking facilities throughout the state. OFAM oversees installation of electric vehicle charging stations in DGS-owned garages.
- Manages the quarterly state surplus property and automotive auctions.
- Procures and manages the state's multimillion dollar airline, rental car, fuel card and lodging contracts to obtain the lowest possible rates and fares for state employee travel. OFAM also manages the DGS Green Lodging Program, which certifies hotels for their energy efficiency, water conservation and other environmentally friendly practices.
