

Office of Public School Construction (OPSC)



The Office of Public School Construction facilitates the processing of School Facility Program construction applications to make voter-approved state bond matching funds available to qualifying school districts. The office implements and administers the \$42 billion voter-approved program. The Office of Public School Construction:



- Processes School Facility Program construction applications to determine eligibility.
- Processes applications for construction projects, including charter school facilities, career technical education, financial hardship, and health and safety grants.
- Assists school districts throughout the life cycle of a school facilities construction project.
- Provides outreach to small school districts seeking school construction funding.
- Performs closeout reviews of school facility construction project expenditures.
- Advises state agencies, school districts, local auditors and other stakeholders in K-12 local audit guide policies and procedures.
- Serves as staff to the State Allocation Board, including the preparation of regulations, policies and procedures.



Fast Facts

- Processes applications for school construction project funding.
- Accounts for and tracks bond authority and cash proceeds for bond accountability and financial reporting.
- Performs closeout reviews for school construction project expenditures.
