

Real Estate Services Division (RES D)



The Real Estate Services Division is a full-service real estate organization. Its highest priority is to provide the highest level of customer service in fulfilling state agencies' facility and real property needs. The Real Estate Services Division:



- Designs and builds sustainable state facilities that are energy- and water-efficient and environmentally friendly.
- Does not oversee every state-owned building in California. Approximately 30 state agencies ranging from the California Highway Patrol to the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation own scores of structures statewide that fall under each department's respective building authority.
- Is responsible for everything from asset planning, property sales and acquisition to leasing and property management, and building maintenance, among other responsibilities.
- Manages approximately 1,800 leases statewide.
- Partners with the Capitol Area Development Authority to develop a vibrant community in downtown Sacramento and create an environment that is walkable and accessible to public transportation.
