SUMMARY: Hundreds of surplus items ranging from office furniture and computers, to pocket knives, snow globes, and fine jewelry and watches seized by the California Highway Patrol or surrendered to the National Transportation Security Administration will be available for bidding by the general public. (Full list of items available [here](#)). Many items are sold in bulk packages, while some are sold individually.

NEW PAYMENT POLICY: DGS has instituted new payment procedure which is designed to streamline the purchase process at state auctions. Under this new policy:

- DGS no longer requires a cash deposit to receive a bid paddle.
- DGS will no longer accept cash for purchases.
- Only credit card or cashier's check will be accepted as forms of payment.
- Each bidder is required to fill out a [Registration Form](#) (PDF) and present their driver's license or state I.D. before receiving a bid paddle.
