Cal eProcure is a feature of the Financial Information System for California (FI\$Cal).

What is FI\$Cal?

FI\$Cal is a business transformation project for the state of California in the areas of budgeting, accounting, procurement, and cash management. The project will prepare the state systems and workforce to function in an integrated financial management system environment. FI\$Cal is a historic partnership between the Department of Finance, the State Controller's Office, the State Treasurer's Office and the Department of General Services.

Why Cal eProcure?

Cal eProcure is designed to improve the experience of businesses selling products and services to the state of California. Launching December 2015, suppliers can register and create a profile.

Registered suppliers can:

 Maintain notifications for bidding opportunities advertised in the California State Contracts Register (CSCR)

 Apply for or renew Small Business/Disabled Veteran Business Enterprise (SB/DVBE) certification


 Follow procurement transactions including purchase orders, receipts, invoices and payments

 Maintain supplier record and contact information

Businesses will need to register through Cal eProcure to continue to receive bid notifications.

WHY IS CAL ePROCURE IMPORTANT FOR MY BUSINESS?

Starting in December 2015, Cal eProcure will replace BidSync as the portal for the California State Contracts Register (CSCR), the State Contracting and Procurement Registration System (SCPRS), the online SB/DVBE certification and queries, and statewide Leveraged Procurement Agreement (LPA) search functions.
