

## Leveraged Procurement Agreements (LPA) and Contract FAQs

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**Q. Have all of the LPAs been uploaded?**

A. All LPAs have been uploaded, except for State Price Schedules (SPS). You may view the SPS contracts at [www.pd.dgs.ca.gov/pricesched/default.htm](http://www.pd.dgs.ca.gov/pricesched/default.htm).

**Q. Can't locate CMAS/LPAs because of the title.**

A. The DGS-PD is standardizing the naming convention for LPAs to improve the eP contracts search tool. In the meantime, please use the old CMAS database at [http://www.pd.dgs.ca.gov/ctmas/contracts\\_REAL.htm](http://www.pd.dgs.ca.gov/ctmas/contracts_REAL.htm). You can also sort by contract type such as statewides or master service agreements.

**Q. LPA search does not provide results on expired contracts even when the "include expired contract" box is selected.**

A. Only LPAs that were active just prior to eP's 3/16/09 go-live date are available. Therefore, only a small number of expired contracts will appear. Note that "include expired contracts" means "in addition to" any active contracts meeting your search criteria.

**Q. Can I search for contracts in alphabetical order?**

A. Yes. Click on "title" to alphabetize the list of contracts.

**Q. When searching LPAs for CSSI contracts, what category is it under?**

A. Statewides

**Q. How will the contracts work when the catalog line items are tied to the Oil Price Information System (OPIS), e.g. fuel.**

A. They will be using a variable price and the buyers should keep the documents regarding the price available so the amounts can be reconciled.
