- A total 18 projects (43 separate buildings) are pursuing LEED-Silver certification. This is in addition to six projects that have already achieved LEED certification. LEED certification will be completed for these 43 buildings within three months of occupancy as shown in the schedule.

- Beyond – All new projects meeting the criteria of the Executive Order are being budgeted to meet LEED Silver certification requirements
- An MOU has been completed between the U.S. Green Building Council and the DGS to cooperate in the LEED Certification of State buildings. The MOU confirms California's commitment to LEED while providing technical assistance and deep discounts from the USGBC.
- DGS is developing procedures to ensure buildings smaller than 10,000 square feet meet LEED Silver standards without certification required.
