

Benchmarking: the first step


- Establish 2003 baseline energy use against which all energy savings can be measured & track progress
- 2006: Manually benchmarked over 200 large buildings
 - Time-intensive, error-prone process
- 2007: How can we streamline benchmarking for tens of thousands of State buildings?



Facilities Benchmarked Manually, 2006


(time-intensive process)

Facilities Ready for Utility Data, 2007 *(automated process going forward)*

Total area of State facilities is over

Benchmarking: To Do

- Collect remaining facility data from agencies by June 15 and upload into the database (U.S. EPA's Portfolio Manager)
- Share Dept. accounts with Agency and State accounts, already created
- Expand the current list of participating utilities
 - PG&E, SMUD, SCE, SoCalGas, SDG&E
- Retrieve and upload monthly data from non-participating utilities once a year
