QUARTERLY DATA REPORT
FIRST QUARTER 2011 - 2012 FISCAL YEAR
JULY 1, 2011 - SEPTEMBER 30, 2011**

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The Interagency Agreement (IA) between the California Department of Education (CDE) and the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) requires OAH to report on a quarterly basis certain information related to mediations and due process and expedited hearings, as well as information required to be maintained according to state and federal law.¹ The following report addresses those IA reporting requirements.

CASE FILINGS²

During the first quarter of fiscal year 2011-2012, OAH received 777 new case filings.³ For a comprehensive chart of the number of filings since 2005, please see Attachment A at page 21.

CASES BY FILING PARTY

Overall, there were 777 total cases filed this quarter, which consisted of 665 student-filed cases and 112 district-filed cases.⁴ Of the student-filed cases, seven cases involved both expedited and non-expedited issues (dual hearings), with no cases that were exclusively expedited issues.⁵ Of the district-filed cases, two cases involved expedited issues and no cases involved both expedited and non-expedited issues (dual hearing).⁶ Of the 777 cases filed, seven requests by students and no requests by districts were for a due process hearing only. A detailed list of all student-filed cases this quarter broken down by district appears in Attachment B beginning on page 22.

Of the 777 cases opened by OAH this quarter, 770 requests were for mediation related to due process hearing or mediation-only this quarter.⁷ Of the 770 requests for mediation, 42 were requests for mediation-only.⁸ The remaining 728 requests for mediation were related to due process hearing requests.⁹ Of the total requests for mediation, seven student-filed cases and no district-filed cases involved both expedited and non-expedited issues (dual hearings).¹⁰



LEGAL REPRESENTATION

During the fourth quarter, 777 requests for due process were filed, which consisted of 665 student-filed requests and 112 district-filed requests. Of the 665 cases filed by students requesting due process, 514 cases (77 percent) were filed by attorneys; of the 112 district-filed cases, 87 cases (78 percent) were filed by attorneys.¹¹ Of the 777 cases filed this quarter, 601 cases (77 percent) were filed by attorneys. This fiscal year, 77 percent of student cases and 78 percent of district cases were filed with legal representation.



GRADE LEVEL

The majority of the 777 cases filed this quarter originated from students in the primary grades (397 cases), followed by those in high school (182 cases), junior high school (105 cases) and preschool (85 cases). The grade level of the student was not specified in eight of the case filings.¹²



ISSUES AND REMEDIES

Cases filed this quarter involved a variety of issues and requested remedies. The number of issues raised varied per case, with some cases raising only one issue, and others raising several issues. The most common issues raised in the 777 cases filed this quarter, were placement (464 cases) and assessment (307 cases). Other issues included: designated instruction and services (224 cases), speech and language services (237 cases), occupational therapy services (175 cases), one-to-one aide services (118 cases), goals and objectives (100 cases), procedural violations (95 cases), eligibility (80 cases), extended school year services (53 cases), mental health services (32 cases), private services (26 cases), and discipline (one case). Compensatory education was requested as a remedy in 302 cases and reimbursement was requested as a remedy in 273 cases.¹³

ELIGIBILITY CATEGORY ¹⁴


The majority of cases filed this quarter involved students identified under the eligibility category of Autistic-Like Behaviors (270 cases). Other identified areas of eligibility included: Specific Learning Disability (130 cases), Speech or Language Impairment (98 cases), Other Health Impaired (96 cases), Emotional Disturbance (56 cases), Intellectual Disability (25 cases), Orthopedic Impairment (18 cases), Deafness (six cases), Traumatic Brain Injury (four cases), and Hearing Impairment (two cases). The student’s area of eligibility was not identified in 187 cases.¹⁵



CLOSED CASES

During this quarter, 822 cases were closed. Currently, 658 cases remain pending.¹⁶ Of the 658 cases pending, 638 are related to due process hearing requests and 20 are related to mediation-only requests. Of the 822 cases closed, 769 were related to due process hearing requests and 53 were related to mediation-only requests. Of the 822 cases closed, 801 (97 percent) were resolved in some manner without need for a due process hearing.¹⁷ For the fiscal year to date, 97 percent of cases have resolved without need for a due process hearing.




The majority of cases closed this quarter were resolved during mediation (335 cases), followed by those that settled outside the mediation or resolution session process (314 cases), and those cases withdrawn by the filing party without explanation (109 cases). Additionally this quarter, 11 cases resolved during the resolution session¹⁸, six cases were dismissed after failing to amend following a notice of insufficiency, eight mediation-only cases were not settled at mediation, 10 cases were dismissed due to inactivity, six cases were dismissed by a motion to dismiss, and two cases were closed for other reasons. Out of the 822 cases closed this quarter, 21 were closed following a hearing and decision on the merits.





MEDIATIONS

This quarter, 555 mediations were held. The mediations were held in cases opened this quarter and in cases that were pending from prior quarters. Of the 555 mediations held this quarter, in 29 cases an additional mediation session was scheduled. Of the 555 mediations held, 512 were related to due process hearing requests, one case involved expedited issues, four cases were related to a dual hearing request (which involve expedited and non-expedited issues) and 38 were related to mediation-only requests.

For mediation requests related to due process hearing, 351 cases reached an agreement at mediation,¹⁹ and 30 mediation-only cases reached an agreement,²⁰ for a total of 381 cases resulting in an agreement.²¹ In the two cases involving expedited issues that went to mediation, one case reached an agreement. In the seven dual cases, which involve both expedited and non-expedited issues that went to mediation, four reached an agreement.²²

Out of the 555 mediations held this quarter, mediation was successful in 381²³ cases (69 percent), with 174 mediations resulting in impasse. At the end of this quarter, 308 cases have mediations pending²⁴ and 633 cases have hearings pending.²⁵




For the 2011-2012 fiscal year, OAH has conducted 555 mediations, with 381 resulting in an agreement and 174 resulting in impasse. The overall mediation success rate for fiscal year 2011-2012 is 69 percent. For the 2011-2012 fiscal year, 97 percent of cases have resolved without need for a due process hearing decision.



DUE PROCESS HEARINGS

During the first quarter, out of the 822 cases closed, 21 final decisions were issued. Of the 21 decisions issued, 20 were issued within the 45-day timeline plus extension, and no decisions were issued late.²⁶ One decision was issued in a case with expedited issues and no changes of placement were ordered for this quarter.²⁷ Overall, this quarter, 100 percent of decisions were issued within the requisite timeline. For the 2011-2012 fiscal year, OAH has issued 21 decisions and 100 percent have been issued within the requisite timelines.

Based upon the issues for hearing identified by the parties, students prevailed on all issues in four hearings (19 percent) and districts prevailed on all issues in 14 hearings (67 percent). In three of the 21 decisions issued (14 percent), the issues in the decision were split between student and



district, with students prevailing on six issues and districts prevailing on 34 issues.²⁸ For the current fiscal year, students have prevailed on all issues in four hearings (19 percent), districts have prevailed on all issues in 14 hearings (67 percent), and three cases (14 percent) resulted in a split decision of the issues. Copies of all decisions have been provided to CDE and have been posted on the OAH website.

Of the 21 decisions issued this quarter, three cases involved preschool students, 10 cases involved elementary school students, one case involved a middle school student, and seven cases involved high school students.

On average, the due process hearings lasted four days, with students using 53 percent of the hearing time to present their cases and districts using 46 percent of hearing time for case presentation.²⁹ During case presentation, students called an average of four witnesses per case and the districts called an average of five witnesses per case.³⁰

The hearings involved multiple areas of disability. RESOLUTION SESSIONS

The IDEA requires school districts to hold resolution sessions within 15 days of receipt of a student’s complaint. While there is no legal requirement to report this data to OAH, CDE requests that OAH track this information. Accordingly, OAH sends letters to school districts requesting them to report for each case if a resolution session was held, the outcome of each session, and other information about each session. This quarter, based on the information OAH received, 103 resolution sessions were reported as held and 100 were reported as not held. Of the 103 resolutions sessions reported as held, there were no sessions regarding expedited cases.³¹ Attachment C, beginning on page 38, reports all resolution session information reported to OAH.

MOTIONS

Prehearing motions and Notices of Insufficiency (NOI) comprise a substantial amount of the work completed by administrative law judges. For this quarter, 360 prehearing motions and 59 NOIs were filed by the parties and ruled upon by OAH. Of the 360 prehearing motions that were ruled on by OAH, 92 were filed by students, 82 were filed by districts or other local education agencies and 186 motions were stipulated.³² Of the 59 NOIs filed, nine of the complaints were found insufficient, 19 were found partially sufficient, and 31 were found sufficient. Six cases were dismissed for insufficiency after failing to amend the complaint.³³

There were 360 prehearing motions filed this quarter. Of the 92 motions filed by students, 52 were granted, one was granted in part and 39 were denied. Of the 82 motions filed by districts or other local education agencies, 35 were granted, 16 were granted in part, 29 were denied, and two were deemed moot. Of the remaining 186 stipulated motions filed by either students or districts, 179 were granted, one was granted in part, five were denied, and one was deemed moot.³⁴

The prehearing motions involved a variety of issues, with the largest number involving motions to continue (206 motions).



NON-ENGLISH-SPEAKING STUDENTS AND INTERPRETERS

During this quarter, 93 non-English-speaking students were identified through the due process hearing request forms.³⁵ Of the 93 non-English-speaking students, 78 students spoke Spanish, six students spoke Vietnamese, four students spoke Korean, two students spoke Mandarin, one spoke Japanese, one spoke Farsi, and one spoke Cantonese. OAH received 104 requests for the assistance of an interpreter at a hearing or mediation³⁶.

STUDENTS OF COLOR


CDE has requested that OAH collect data on the number of students of color accessing the system. To facilitate this request, OAH’s due process hearing request form asks the parties to voluntarily provide this information. However, not all hearing requests are made using the OAH form. This quarter, 17 students reported as being a student of color and 18 students reported as not being a student of color.³⁷ The remaining students did not state whether they were a student of color.

TRANSCRIPT REQUESTS AND APPEALS

Data on the number of appeals to state and federal courts and appellate outcomes are collected on an ongoing basis and include all cases that OAH was notified were appealed since July 2005. This quarter, OAH received 18 requests for transcripts, and was notified of five new appeals filed.³⁸

OAH is currently working to update the appeals tracking process in the effort to provide the most accurate information. Based on correspondence with the parties and filings that have been provided to OAH, 162 cases have been appealed since July 2005. Currently, of the 162 cases that have been appealed, 45 have been settled, 43 have been dismissed, 35 have been upheld, 19 are pending, eight have been remanded, five cases were withdrawn by the filing party without explanation, five have been reversed, one has been affirmed, and one overturned.

A detailed list of cases on appeal and their outcomes after appeal is included in Attachment D beginning at page 55. OAH is also now tracking appeals that have been further appealed to a higher court, the details of which can be found in Attachment E at page 62. Due to the difficulty in identifying which cases are appealed and the appellate outcomes, parties are invited to notify OAH of any case on appeal or any outcome on appeal that is not included in Attachment D or Attachment E.

MEDIATION AND HEARING EVALUATIONS

OAH is required to send evaluations to all parties attending mediations and hearings. The evaluations contain a rating scale of 1 to 5, with 1 being poor/very dissatisfied and 5 being excellent/extremely satisfied. The evaluations ask the parties to evaluate the mediation, the administrative law judge and OAH in general.

This quarter, 164 mediation evaluations were returned to OAH. Evaluations were completed by parents (37 cases), legal counsel for parents (13 cases), advocates for parents (four cases), school district representatives (53 cases), and legal counsel for districts (seven cases). In 50 cases, the evaluator did not indicate his or her role in the mediation.
