The Interagency Agreement (IA) between the California Department of Education (CDE) and the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) requires OAH to report on a quarterly basis certain information related to mediations and due process and expedited hearings, as well as information required to be maintained according to state and federal law.¹ The following report addresses those IA reporting requirements.

CASE FILINGS²

During the third quarter of fiscal year 2010-2011, OAH received 684 new case filings.³

Cases by Filing Party

Overall, there were 684 total cases filed this quarter, which consisted of 562 student-filed cases and 122 district-filed cases. Of the student-filed cases, eight cases involved expedited issues and 15 cases involved both expedited and non-expedited issues (dual hearings).⁴ Of the district-filed cases, three cases involved expedited issues and one case involved both expedited and non-expedited issues (dual hearing). Of the 684 cases filed, one request by students and one request by districts were for a due process hearing only. The 684 cases filed this quarter also included 27 student-filed and 25 district-filed mediation-only requests. A detailed list of all student-filed cases this quarter broken down by district appears in Attachment B beginning on page 22.

Of the 684 cases opened by OAH this quarter, 682 requests were for mediation related to due process hearing or mediation-only this quarter.⁵ Of the 682 requests for mediation, 52 were requests for mediation-only.⁶ The remaining 630 requests for mediation were related to due process hearing requests.⁷ Of the total requests for mediation, 15 student-filed cases involved both expedited and non-expedited issues (dual hearings).⁸



Legal Representation

During the third quarter, 684 requests for due process were filed, which consisted of 562 student-filed requests and 122 district-filed requests. Of the 562 cases filed by students requesting due process, 421 cases (75 percent) were filed by attorneys. Of the 122 district-filed cases, 91 cases (75 percent) were filed by attorneys.⁹ Of the 684 cases filed this quarter, 512 cases (75 percent) were filed by attorneys. This fiscal year, 76 percent of student cases and 76 percent of district cases were filed with legal representation.



Grade Level

The majority of the 684 cases filed this quarter originated from students in the primary grades (343 cases), followed by those in high school (149 cases), junior high school (102 cases) and preschool (78 cases). The grade level of the student was not specified in 12 of the case filings.¹⁰



Issues and Remedies

Cases filed this quarter involved a variety of issues and requested remedies. The number of issues raised varied per case, with some cases raising only one issue, and others raising several issues. The most common issues raised in the 684 cases filed this quarter, were placement (354 cases) and assessment (298 cases). Other issues included: speech and language services (221 cases), designated instruction and services (215 cases), occupational therapy services (112 cases), one-to-one aide services (106 cases), procedural violations (90 cases), goals and objectives (64 cases), mental health services (41 cases), private services (38 cases), extended school year services (33 cases), eligibility (31 cases) and discipline (three cases). Compensatory education was requested as a remedy in 243 cases and reimbursement was requested as a remedy in 209 cases.¹¹

Eligibility Category ¹²

The majority of cases filed this quarter involved students identified under the eligibility category of Autistic-Like Behaviors (208 cases). Other identified areas of eligibility included: Specific Learning Disability (123 cases), Speech or Language Impairment (101 cases), Other Health Impaired (85 cases), Emotional Disturbance (79 cases), Intellectual Disability¹³ (34 cases), Hearing Impairment (13 cases), Orthopedic Impairment (12 cases), Visually Impaired (10 cases), Deafness (eight cases), Traumatic Brain Injury (five cases) and Deaf/Blind (one case). The student's area of eligibility was not identified in 164 cases.¹⁴






CLOSED CASES

During this quarter, 566 cases were closed. Currently, 658 cases remain pending.¹⁵ Of the 658 cases pending, 617 are related to due process hearing requests and 41 are related to mediation-only requests. Of the 566 cases closed, 533 were related to due process hearing requests and 33 were related to mediation-only requests. Of the 566 cases closed, 539 (95%) were resolved in some manner without need for a due process hearing.¹⁶ For the fiscal year to date, 96 percent of cases have resolved without need for a due process hearing.




The majority of cases closed this quarter were settled outside the mediation or resolution session process (222 cases), followed by those that resolved during mediation (165 cases), and those cases withdrawn by the filing party without explanation (116 cases). Additionally this quarter, 19 cases resolved during the resolution session, six cases were dismissed after failing to amend following a notice of insufficiency, six mediation-only cases were not settled at mediation, two cases were dismissed by a motion to dismiss, two cases were closed for other reasons and one case was dismissed due to inactivity. Out of the 566 cases closed this quarter, 27 were closed following a hearing and decision on the merits.

Mediations

This quarter, 364 mediations were held. The mediations were held in cases opened this quarter and in cases that were pending from prior quarters. Of the 364 mediations held this quarter, in 32 cases an additional mediation session was scheduled. Of the 364 mediations held, 338 were related to due process hearing requests, one case involved expedited issues, three cases were related to a dual hearing request (which involve expedited and non-expedited issues) and 26 were related to mediation-only requests.


For mediation requests related to due process hearing, 213 cases reached an agreement at mediation,¹⁷ and 15 mediation-only cases reached an agreement, for a total of 228 cases resulting in an agreement.¹⁸ In the four cases involving expedited issues that went to mediation, four cases reached an agreement.¹⁹

Out of the 364 mediations held this quarter, mediation was successful in 228²⁰ cases (63 percent), with 136 mediations resulting in impasse. At the end of this quarter, 333 cases have mediations pending²¹ and 617 cases have hearings pending.²²





For the 2010-2011 fiscal year, OAH has conducted 1,128 mediations, with 737 resulting in an agreement and 391 resulting in impasse. The overall mediation success rate for fiscal year 2010-2011 is 65 percent. Overall for the 2010-2011 fiscal year, 96 percent of cases have resolved without need for a due process hearing decision.

Due Process Hearings

During the third quarter, out of the 566 cases closed, 27 final decisions were issued. Of the 27 decisions issued, one decision was issued within the standard 45-day timeline, 24 were issued within the 45-day timeline plus extension, and no decisions were issued late.²³ Two decisions were issued on cases with expedited issues and no changes of placement were ordered for this quarter.²⁴ Overall, this quarter, 100 percent of decisions were issued within the requisite timeline. For the 2010-2011 fiscal year, OAH has issued 74 decisions and 100 percent have been issued within the requisite timelines.

Based upon the issues for hearing identified by the parties, students prevailed on all issues in four hearings (15 percent) and districts prevailed on all issues in 14 hearings (63 percent). In six of the 27 decisions issued (22 percent), the issues in the decision were split between student and district, with students prevailing on 14 issues and districts prevailing on 37 issues.²⁵ For the current fiscal year, students have prevailed on all issues in 10 hearings (14 percent), districts have prevailed on all issues in 47 hearings (63 percent), and 17 cases (23 percent) resulted in a



split decision of the issues. Copies of all decisions have been provided to CDE and have been posted on the OAH website.

Of the 27 decisions issued this quarter, one case involved a preschool student, 14 cases involved elementary school students, five cases involved middle school students, and seven cases involved high school students.

On average, the due process hearings lasted three days, with students using 54 percent of the hearing time to present their cases and districts using 46 percent of hearing time for case presentation.²⁶ During case presentation, students called an average of five witnesses per case and the districts called an average of four witnesses per case.²⁷

The hearings involved multiple areas of disability. The cases involved students identified with Autistic-Like Behaviors (nine cases), Emotional Disturbance (eight cases), Speech or Language Impairment (four cases), Intellectual Disability (three cases) and Specific Learning Disability (three cases).

Resolution Sessions

The IDEA requires school districts to hold resolution sessions within 15 days of receipt of a student's complaint. While there is no legal requirement to report this data to OAH, CDE requests that OAH track this information. Accordingly, OAH sends letters to school districts asking if they held a resolution session and the outcome of that session. This quarter, based on the information OAH received, 89 resolution sessions were reported as held and 119 were

reported as not held. Of the 89 resolutions sessions reported as held, three cases were regarding expedited cases.²⁸

Motions

Prehearing motions and Notices of Insufficiency (NOI) comprise a substantial amount of the work completed by administrative law judges. For this quarter, 313 prehearing motions and 45 NOIs were filed by the parties and considered and ruled upon by OAH. Of the 313 prehearing motions that were ruled on by OAH, 91 were filed by students, 76 were filed by districts and 146 motions were stipulated or ruled moot.²⁹ Of the 45 NOIs filed, 19 were found insufficient, 7 were partially sufficient, and 19 were sufficient. Six cases were dismissed for insufficiency after failing to amend the complaint.³⁰

There were 313 prehearing motions filed this quarter. Of the 91 motions filed by students, 56 were granted, one was granted in part and 34 were denied. Of the 76 motions filed by districts, 40 were granted, six were granted in part, 29 were denied and one was determined to be moot. Of the remaining 146 stipulated motions filed by either students or districts, 138 were granted, three were granted in part and five were denied.³¹

The prehearing motions involved a variety of issues, with the largest number involving motions to continue (173 motions).



NON-ENGLISH SPEAKING STUDENTS AND INTERPRETERS

During this quarter, 79 non-English-speaking students were identified through the due process hearing request forms.³² Of the 79 non-English-speaking students, 74 students spoke Spanish, three students spoke Vietnamese, one student spoke Armenian, and one student spoke Mandarin. OAH received 66 requests for the assistance of an interpreter at a hearing or mediation.

STUDENTS OF COLOR

CDE has requested that OAH collect data on the number of students of color accessing the system. To facilitate this request, OAH amended its due process hearing request form to ask the parties to voluntarily provide this information. However, not all hearing requests are made using the OAH form. This quarter, 12 students reported as being a student of color and 33 students reported as not being a student of color.³³ The remaining students did not state whether they were a student of color.



TRANSCRIPT REQUESTS AND APPEALS

Data on the number of appeals and appellate outcomes are collected on an ongoing basis and include all cases that OAH was notified were appealed since July 2005. This quarter, OAH received 21 requests for transcripts, and was not notified of any new appeal filed on any case.³⁴

Based on correspondence with the parties and filings that have been provided to OAH, 192 cases have been appealed since July 2005. Currently, of the 192 cases that have been appealed, 38 are pending a decision from an appellate court, 44 decisions issued by OAH have been upheld, seven decisions issued by OAH have been remanded, 10 decisions issued by OAH were reversed, 38 cases settled, 50 were dismissed, and five cases were withdrawn by the filing party without explanation.



A detailed list of cases on appeal and the outcomes after appeal is listed in Attachment C beginning at page 39. Due to the difficulty in identifying which cases are appealed and the appellate outcomes, parties are invited to notify OAH of any case on appeal or any outcome on appeal that is not included in Attachment C.

MEDIATION AND HEARING EVALUATIONS

OAH is required to send evaluations to all parties attending mediations and hearings. The evaluations contain a rating scale of 1 to 5, with 1 being poor/very dissatisfied and 5 being

excellent/extremely satisfied. The evaluations ask the parties to evaluate the mediation, the administrative law judge and OAH in general.

This quarter, 161 mediation evaluations were returned to OAH. Evaluations were completed by parents (37 cases), legal counsel for parents (eight cases), advocates for parents (one case), school district representatives (59 cases), and legal counsel for districts (16 cases). In 40 cases, the evaluator did not indicate his or her role in the mediation.
