Quarterly Data Report
Fourth Quarter 2013 - 2014 Fiscal Year
April 1, 2014 – June 30, 2014**

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The Interagency Agreement (IA) between the California Department of Education (CDE) and the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) requires OAH to report on a quarterly basis certain information related to mediations and due process and expedited hearings, as well as information required to be maintained according to state and federal law.¹ The following report addresses those IA reporting requirements.

CASE FILINGS²

During the third quarter of fiscal year 2013-2014, OAH received 1,099 new case filings. For a comprehensive chart of the number of filings since 2005, please see Attachment A at page 21.

CASES BY FILING PARTY

Overall, there were 1,099 total cases filed this quarter, which consisted of 964 student-filed cases and 135 district-filed cases.³ Of the student-filed cases, 16 cases involved both expedited and non-expedited issues (dual hearings), and four cases that were exclusively

expedited issues.⁴ Of the district-filed cases, there were three cases that involved expedited issues and no case that involved a dual hearing.⁵ Of the 1,099 cases filed, there were four requests by a student for a due process hearing only, and one request by a district. A detailed list of all student-filed cases this quarter broken down by district appears in Attachment B beginning on page 22.

Of the 1,099 cases opened by OAH this quarter, 1,094 had requests for mediation related to due process hearing or mediation-only.⁶ Of the 1,094 requests for mediation, 79 were requests for mediation-only.⁷ The remaining 1,015 requests for mediation were related to due process hearing requests.⁸ Of the total requests for mediation, four student-filed cases and three district-filed cases involved expedited issues only, and 16 student-filed cases and no district-filed cases involved dual hearings.⁹



LEGAL REPRESENTATION

During this quarter, 1,099 cases were filed, which consisted of 964 student-filed requests and 135 district-filed requests. Of the 964 cases filed by students, 780 cases (81 percent) were filed by attorneys; of the 135 district-filed cases, 107 cases (79 percent) were filed by attorneys.¹⁰ Of the 1,099 cases filed this quarter, 887 cases (81 percent) were filed by attorneys.


This fiscal year, 83 percent of student cases and 74 percent of district cases were filed with legal representation.

The majority of the 1,099 cases filed this quarter originated from students in the primary grades (561 cases), followed by those in high school (266 cases), junior high school (156 cases) and preschool (116 cases). The grade level of the student was specified in all of the case filings.¹¹


ISSUES AND REMEDIES

Cases filed this quarter involved a variety of issues and requested remedies. The number of issues raised varied per case, with some cases raising only one issue, and others raising several issues. The most common issues raised in the 1,099 cases filed this quarter were designated instruction and services (751 cases) and placement (649 cases). Other issues included: assessment (554 cases), speech and language services (373 cases), occupational therapy services (258 cases), one-to-one aide services (162 cases), goals and objectives (129 cases), eligibility (117 cases), extended school year services (116 cases), procedural violations (98 cases), private services (77 cases), ABA services (66 cases), mental health services (54 cases), and discipline (23 cases). Compensatory education was requested as a remedy in 474 cases and reimbursement was requested as a remedy in 393 cases.¹²


The majority of cases filed this quarter involved students identified under the eligibility category of Autistic-Like Behaviors (329 cases). Other identified areas of eligibility included: Specific Learning Disability (159 cases), Other Health Impaired (150 cases), Speech or Language Impairment (126 cases), Emotional Disturbance (81 cases), Intellectual Disability (38 cases), Multiple Disabilities (20 cases), Orthopedic Impairment (19 cases), Deafness (eight cases), Hearing Impairment (eight cases), Visual Impairment (five cases), Traumatic Brain

Injury (two cases), and Deaf/Blind (two cases). The student’s area of eligibility was not identified in 315 cases.¹⁴




CLOSED CASES

During this quarter, 975 cases were closed. Currently, 829 cases remain pending, of which there are five student-filed and no district-filed requests that involve dual hearings and one district-filed request and no student-filed requests that involve expedited issues only.¹⁵ Of the 829 cases pending, 803 are related to due process hearing requests and 26 are related to mediation-only requests. Of the 975 cases closed, 909 were related to due process hearing requests and 66 were related to mediation-only requests. Of the 975 cases closed, 938 (96 percent) were resolved in some manner without need for a due process hearing.¹⁶ For the fiscal year to date, 97 percent of cases have resolved without need for a due process hearing.



The majority of cases closed this quarter were settled outside the mediation or resolution session process (371 cases), followed by those that were resolved during mediation (361 cases), and those cases withdrawn by the filing party without explanation (124 cases). Additionally this quarter, 51 cases resolved during the resolution session,¹⁷ 17 mediation-only cases were not settled at mediation, nine mediation-only cases were closed due to a party declining participation, four cases were dismissed by an order granting motion to dismiss, one case was dismissed after failing to amend following a notice of insufficiency, and no case was closed at a settlement conference, due to inactivity or other reasons. Out of the 975 cases closed this quarter, 37 were closed following a hearing and decision on the merits.

MEDIATIONS

This quarter, 543 mediations were held. The mediations were held in cases opened this quarter and in cases that were pending from prior quarters. Of the 543 mediations held this quarter, in 27 cases an additional mediation session was scheduled. Of the 543 mediations held, 493 were related to due process hearing requests and 50 were related to mediation-only requests. Of the 493 mediations held related to due process hearing requests, six cases involved only expedited issues and six cases were related to dual hearing requests.

Of the mediation requests related to due process hearings, 316 cases reached an agreement at mediation,¹⁸ and 30 mediation-only cases reached an agreement,¹⁹ for a total of 346 cases resulting in an agreement.²⁰ Four cases involving only expedited issues requested mediation, and two reached an agreement at mediation. Of the six dual cases, which involved both expedited and non-expedited issues that went to mediation, four reached an agreement.²¹

Out of the 543 mediations held this quarter, mediation was successful in 346 cases (64 percent), with 197 mediations resulting in impasse. At the end of this quarter, 425 cases have mediations pending,²² and 803 cases have hearings pending.²³

For the 2013-2014 fiscal year, OAH has conducted 2,025 mediations, with 1,320 resulting in an agreement and 705 resulting in impasse. The overall mediation resolution rate for fiscal year 2013-2014 was 65 percent.



DUE PROCESS HEARINGS

During this quarter, 37 final decisions were issued. Of the 37 decisions issued, 31 were issued within the 45-day timeline plus extensions, four were issued within the 45-day timeline, two were issued within the expedited timeline, and no decision was issued late.²⁴ There were two decisions issued in a case with expedited issues and one change of placement was ordered for this quarter.²⁵ Overall, this quarter, 100 percent of decisions were issued within the requisite



timeline. For the 2013-2014 fiscal year, OAH has issued 121 decisions and 100 percent have been issued within the requisite timelines.²⁶

Based upon the issues for hearing identified by the parties, during this quarter districts prevailed on all issues in 20 hearings (54 percent) and students prevailed on all issues in six hearings (16 percent). In 11 of the 37 decisions issued (30 percent), the issues in the decision were split between student and district, with students prevailing on 30 issues and districts prevailing on 103 issues.²⁷ For the current fiscal year, students have prevailed on all issues in 13 hearings (11 percent), districts have prevailed on all issues in 64 hearings (53 percent), and 44 cases (36 percent) resulted in a split decision of the issues. Copies of all decisions have been provided to CDE and have been posted on the OAH website.

Of the 37 decisions issued this quarter, two cases involved preschool students, 15 cases involved elementary school students, five cases involved middle school students, and 15 cases involved high school students.

On average, the due process hearings lasted four days, with students using 49 percent of the hearing time to present their cases and districts using 47 percent of the hearing time for case presentation.²⁸ During case presentation, students called an average of six witnesses and districts called an average of five witnesses per case.²⁹

The hearings involved multiple areas of disability. The cases involved students identified with a disability area of Autistic-Like Behaviors (14 cases), Emotional Disturbance (seven cases), Other Health Impaired (five cases), Orthopedic Impaired (two cases), Deafness (one case), Multiple Disabilities (one case), Specific Learning Disabilities (one case), and Visual Impairment (one case). In five cases the student was found not eligible.

RESOLUTION SESSIONS

The IDEA requires school districts to hold resolution sessions within 15 days of receipt of a student's complaint. While there is no legal requirement to report these data to OAH, CDE requests that OAH track this information. Accordingly, OAH sends letters to school districts requesting them to report for each case if a resolution session was held, the outcome of each session, and other information about each session. This quarter, based on the information OAH received, 150 resolution sessions were reported as held and 318 were reported as not held. Of the 150 resolution sessions reported as held, two cases involved both expedited and non-expedited issues, and no session was held regarding an expedited case.³⁰ Of the cases reported as held, 58 were reported as reaching a signed settlement agreement at the resolution sessions. Attachment C, beginning on page 49, reports all resolution session information reported to OAH this quarter and Attachment D, beginning on page 71, details the cases from this quarter for which OAH did not receive any resolution session data.

MOTIONS

Prehearing motions and Notices of Insufficiency (NOIs) comprise a substantial amount of the work completed by administrative law judges. For this quarter, 378 prehearing motions and 30 NOIs were filed by the parties and ruled upon by OAH. Of the 378 prehearing motions that were ruled on by OAH, 83 were filed by students, 70 were filed by districts or other local education agencies and 225 motions were stipulated.³¹ Of the 30 NOIs filed, 16 of the complaints were found sufficient, seven were found insufficient, and seven were found partially sufficient. One case was dismissed for insufficiency after failing to amend the complaint.³²

There were 378 prehearing motions filed this quarter. Of the 83 motions filed by students, 43 were granted, 35 were denied, three were granted in part, and two were deemed moot. Of the 70 motions filed by districts or other local education agencies, 42 were granted, 18 were denied, eight were granted in part, and two were denied as moot. Of the 225 stipulated motions, 211 were granted, 12 were denied, one was granted in part, and one was denied as moot.³³ The prehearing motions involved a variety of issues, with the largest number involving motions to continue (256 motions).



NON-ENGLISH-SPEAKING STUDENTS AND INTERPRETERS

During this quarter, 274 non-English-speaking students were identified through the due process hearing request forms.³⁴ Of the 274 non-English-speaking students, 254 students spoke Spanish, 10 spoke Korean, four spoke Japanese, two spoke Mandarin, one spoke American Sign Language, one spoke Arabic, one spoke Portuguese, and one spoke Vietnamese.

STUDENTS OF COLOR


CDE has requested that OAH collect data on the number of students of color accessing the system. To facilitate this request, OAH’s due process hearing request form asks the parties to voluntarily provide this information. However, not all hearing requests are made using the OAH form. This quarter, nine students reported as being a student of color and 14 students reported as not being a student of color.³⁶ The remaining students did not state whether they were a student of color.

TRANSCRIPT REQUESTS AND APPEALS

Data on the number of appeals to state and federal courts and appellate outcomes are collected on an ongoing basis and include all cases about which OAH was notified of an appeal since July 2005. This quarter, OAH received 28 requests for transcripts, and was notified of six new appeals filed. Of the appeals reported in previous quarters, one appeal settled.³⁷

Based on correspondence with the parties and filings that have been provided to OAH, 241 cases have been appealed since July 2005. Of the 241 cases that have been appealed, 55 have settled, 52 were upheld, 49 have been dismissed, nine were reversed, six were withdrawn, and six were remanded. There are 19 cases that are currently on appeal and 45 have gone on to further appeal to a higher court.

Due to the difficulty in identifying which cases are appealed and the appellate outcomes, parties are invited to notify OAH of any case on appeal or any outcome on appeal that is not listed in either Attachment E or Attachment F.

MEDIATION AND HEARING EVALUATIONS

OAH is required to send evaluations to all parties attending mediations and hearings. The evaluations contain a rating scale of 1 to 5, with 1 being poor/very dissatisfied and 5 being excellent/extremely satisfied. The evaluations ask the parties to evaluate the mediation or hearing, the administrative law judge and OAH in general.

This quarter, 145 mediation evaluations were completed. Evaluations were completed by parents (34 evaluations), legal counsel for parents (11 evaluations), school district representatives (77 evaluations), legal counsel for districts (19 evaluations), and non-attorney advocates for parents (four evaluations).
