Speedy resolution of the due process hearing is mandated by law; however, a continuance may be granted upon a showing of good cause. (Ed. Code, § 56505, subd. (f)(3).) Here, good cause exists for a continuance because Student retained an attorney within a reasonable time after the August 18, 2009 filing of the District's complaint. Further, Student's requested continuance of less than 30 days is reasonable under the circumstances. The request for continuance is granted.
