The hearing in this matter was scheduled to reconvene on Monday, July 20, 2009. On Sunday, July 19, 2009, Karen Samman, Esq., counsel for the Clovis Unified School District (District) contacted the undersigned Administrative Law Judge (ALJ), to request a continuance of the case due to a family medical emergency. The ALJ thereafter held a conference call with Ms. Samman and Student's mother, who represents Student at hearing. After discussion with the parties, the ALJ found good cause for the continuance requested by the District (Ed. Code, § 56505, subd. (f)(3)), and orally granted the motion for continuance, continuing the hearing for one week. The due process hearing in this matter will therefore reconvene on Monday, July 27, 2009, at 8:30 a.m. at the District's offices located at 1680 David E. Cook Way, Clovis CA 93611.

The parties are also directed to contact the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) in Sacramento, California, at (916) 263-0880, by no later than 1 p.m. on Thursday, July 23, 2009, to confirm whether they are available for a conference call with the ALJ at 2:00 p.m. on Friday, July 24, 2009, to discuss the issue relating to the testimony of Student's

neuropsychology expert. If a party is unavailable for this time, the party is directed to inform OAH of what time on July 24 the party will be available for the conference call.
