ORDER GRANTING REQUEST FOR

RESPONSE

On July 3, 2009, attorney Mandy S. L. Favaloro, on behalf of Student, filed a motion for stay put against the Los Angeles Unified School District (District). On July 7, 2009, attorney Patrick J. Balucan, on behalf of the District, filed a request for extension of time until July 10, 2009, to respond to Student's motion for stay put. Student filed an opposition on July 8, 2009.

DISCUSSION

The District's request for an extension of time is based on the difficulty in obtaining needed documents due to the closure of Student's school for summer break. Because the District's request is for only an extra two days and supported by good cause due to the school's closure, the District's request is granted.

ORDER

The District's request for extension of time to July 10, 2009, to file a response to Student's motion for stay put is granted.
