ORDER ACCEPTING STIPULATION  
AND DISMISSING COMPLAINT

This matter is calendared for due process hearing on November 4, 2009.

On October 30, 2009, a telephonic prehearing conference (PHC) was held before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Charles Marson, Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). Peter A. Sansom, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the San Luis Coastal Unified School District (District). Student's Mother appeared on his behalf. The PHC was recorded.

During the PHC the parties reached a resolution of this matter, which involves a single issue: Whether the District may proceed with an assessment plan dated December 4, 2008. The parties stipulated that the District may proceed with the assessment plan. Mother consented on the record to the assessment plan. There is no longer a controversy between the parties.

ORDER

1. The stipulation of the parties that the District may assess Student pursuant to the assessment plan of December 4, 2009, is accepted, and the District may proceed with the assessment plan forthwith.
2. Mother shall furnish the signed assessment plan to the District as soon as her health permits.
2. All dates currently calendared in this matter are vacated.
3. The matter is dismissed with prejudice.
