ORDER AMENDING NAME OF
PARTY AND CONTINUING
PREHEARING CONFERENCE

On October 28, 2009, a telephonic prehearing conference (PHC) was held before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Charles Marson, Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). Peter A. Sansom, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of the San Luis Coastal Unified School District (District). Student's Mother, appeared on behalf of Student. The PHC was recorded.

Based on discussion with the parties, the ALJ issues the following order:

1. Change of Name of Party. The parties agree that OAH documents referring to Student as "Student" are incorrect. Student's given name is Student. Therefore, on motion of the District, the caption in this matter is amended by striking the name "Student" and inserting the name "Student" in its place. All future pleadings mentioning Student by name shall refer to him as Student.

2. Continuance of PHC. After substantial discussion between the parties resulting in an agreement to resolve this matter today, the prehearing conference is continued to Friday, October 30, 2009, at 1:30 p.m. If the matter is resolved before then, the District shall promptly notify OAH of that fact in writing.
