ORDER GRANTING CONTINUANCE
FOLLOWING INITIAL PREHEARING
CONFERENCE

On March 3, 2010, a telephonic pre-hearing conference (PHC) was held before Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) June R. Lehrman, Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH). Parent appeared on her own behalf, and requested a continuance to obtain legal representation. Mary Kellogg, Attorney at Law, appeared on behalf of District, and opposed the motion for continuance. The PHC was recorded.

Based on discussion of the parties, and good cause appearing, the ALJ vacates the currently-scheduled hearing date and issues the following order:

The Amended PHC Statements may be filed and served by facsimile transmission at (916) 376-6319.
3. Hearing Dates, Times, and Location. The hearing is continued until April 5 and 6, 2010. The hearing shall begin each day at 9:30 a.m. and end at 4:30 p.m, unless otherwise ordered, at 15350 Sherman Way Suite 300 Van Nuys, CA 91406 Room: VN 2.
