ORDER GRANTING PEREMPTORY
CHALLENGE

On March 14, 2011, District filed a peremptory challenge to Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Clara Slifkin hearing this case under Government Code section 11425.40, subdivision (d), and California Code of Regulations, title 1, section 1034.

A party is entitled to one peremptory challenge (disqualification without cause) to an ALJ assigned to an Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH) hearing. (Gov. Code, § 11425.40, subd. (d); Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1034, subds. (a) & (b).) Any challenge to the assigned ALJ shall be made no later than commencement of that prehearing conference. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 1, § 1034, subd. (c).)

District's peremptory challenge is timely and is granted.
